## Rates

There are two Hotels side by side, Ramada and Days Hotel at Zhongshan Park. The program takes place at Ramada Congress Hall. Accommodation is in both Hotels. Do not make reservations to the Hotels directly, because the package rate is for TS, and requires registration to Singapore Lodge as mentioned in the Registration Form.

Packages include:

- \* conference fee with programs  
from 4 (morning, opening) to 8 August (late evening with banquet)
- \* accommodation from 3rd to 9th noon  
(for those attending the TOS Conference it's package will be until 11th noon)
- \* meals (breakfast, 2 tea/coffee breaks, lunch and dinner)  
from 4th to 8th August, and breakfast on 9th.

## Logo of the World Congress

What does it mean?

1. The artist Joma Sipe was "inspired" by MERLION. The **Merlion** (Malay language: *Singa-Laut*) is a well-known icon of Singapore depicted as a mythical creature with a lion's head and the body of a fish. It is widely used as a mascot and national personification of Singapore. The logo is not a replica of Merlion.
2. Two of our Founders, H. P. Blavatsky and H. S. Olcott were both Leos.
3. The lion logo shows strength, leadership, but also fairness, thus portraying great majesty.

4. The colors used were adopted from an original 1886 book publication *Theosophy, Religion and Occult Science* by Henry Olcott. Those colors link directly with Singapore and its Chinese background and history.
